

Donations Presented at Park City C.U. Annual Meeting

Over 300 member/owners of Park City Credit Union gathered Saturday evening, May 7th at Les & Jim's Lincoln Lanes in Merrill for the credit union's annual meeting. Financial results were exceptional and highlighted record-breaking growth in all areas of the operation.

Membership growth was very strong with over 2000 new members welcomed to the credit union in 2010, bringing overall membership to over 22,600 individuals in 8 counties throughout the Northwoods. Checking account growth excelled too, with 850 new checking accounts opened last year. It was also announced that board members James Gaeu, Wilburn Weber, and Leonard LaFrenier were each elected for additional 3-year terms.

The business meeting was coupled with a demonstration of community commitment with several donations announced. Following the tornados that affected Merrill in April, Park City Credit Union has been taking collections to be forwarded for the relief efforts. "We're thrilled to announce that over \$6,000.00 in monetary donations have come in already," said PCCU President/CEO Val Mindak. Park City Credit Union also contributed an additional \$5,000.00 to present the Merrill Chamber Relief Fund and Merrill United Way's

Storm Match with over \$11,000.00 in total. "This is in addition to approximately \$3,000.00 worth of items such as clothing, food, and cleaning supplies, which has come in," said Mindak.

An additional \$613.00 was collected at the meeting, itself, for tornado relief, yet even before the storms hit, the credit union was taking a charitable approach to this year's meeting. All who attended were asked to make a \$5.00 donation, which was distributed to food pantries in Merrill, Tomahawk, Minocqua, and Rhinelander, where Park City Credit Union has offices. In total, over \$1,400.00 was raised to donate to various food pantries.

Many prizes were also awarded, including a grand prize of a "Stay-N-Play" vacation valued at over \$500.00, and the evening concluded with dancing to Neal Zunker and the Music Connection.

Park City Credit Union is a member-owned financial cooperative founded in 1937 and for over 73 years has provided financial products and services to its members. Currently Park City Credit Union provides membership to those who live or work in Lincoln, Oneida, Vilas, Iron, Price, Taylor and Marathon Counties as well as portions of Langlade County. Branch operations are located currently in Merrill, Tomahawk, Minocqua and Rhinelander and at the Merrill High School.
