Park City Credit Union also hopes to use it's new branch in the school to educate students on the importance of money management skills. One tool Park City Credit Union has launched for teens is a game called Money Mission. This educational game was launched in March of 2010. Money Mission offers a learning experience through a game where participants earn and spend virtual money. The game also scores players on happiness. The final score a participant receives is calculated between money use and time worked with the happiness meter.
