

## Over \$2,000.00 Raised for Children at Park City Credit Union



Merrill, Wisconsin – The annual invasion of stuffed animals at Park City Credit Union raised \$2050.00 in support of the Children’s Miracle Network. “That’s a lot of love,” said Joy Turner, Member Service Representative at Park City’s Merrill location.

The program, known as Share-a-Bear, is part of the Credit Union for Kids initiative. Stuffed, plush animals of many varieties are sponsored for use with sick or injured children. The small toys,

which are sponsored for \$5.00 are used as distractions for children undergoing outpatient procedures, and the large toys sponsored for \$10.00 each are given to inpatients. 100% of the funds raised locally are used to help provide, services, treatment, and programs for kids, including the Share-a-Bear program. The local, Children’s Miracle Network serves 17 counties in North Central Wisconsin, including the 7 counties served by Park City Credit Union, which has offices in Merrill, Tomahawk, Minocqua, and Rhinelander.

This is the second consecutive year Park City Credit Union has participated in the voluntary event. “Last year’s efforts were so successful - and our employees had so much fun with it - that we just had to take part again when the opportunity arose,” said Val Mindak, President/CEO of Park City Credit Union. “It’s great to see so many of our members and employees helping the kids.”
