Park City Credit Union Celebrates Growth at 2025 Annual Meeting.

MERRILL, WISC. — Park City Credit Union members, staff, and board members gathered on May 18, 2026, for the 2025 Annual Meeting, celebrating a year of growth and shared success. This year's theme, "Together, We Grow," highlighted the strength of collaboration among the credit union's members, employees, and the communities it serves.

In her annual address to members, Val Mindak, President/CEO of Park City Credit Union said, "We've expanded our reach and capabilities while staying true to our mission of helping members fulfill their dreams."

In 2025, Park City Credit Union exceeded the 25,000-member threshold and paid out \$4.68 million in dividends. The organization finished the year with \$381.2 million in total assets and a 9.91% capital ratio.

"Together, these results reflect our ongoing dedication to sound financial management and the long-term strength of Park City Credit Union," said Val Mindak.

Park City Credit Union increased their footprint across central Wisconsin in 2025. In June, a merger with Wood County Employees Credit Union allowed Park City to serve members in 13 total counties. Furthermore, plans were announced to open a Wausau branch in May of 2026.

When speaking of Park City Credit Union's growth, Val Mindak stated, "These expansions reinforce our promise to meet members where they are by providing accessible banking solutions. Our growth demonstrates our commitment to delivering the Park City Credit Union difference to more communities across central Wisconsin."

Park City Credit Union's growth in 2025 was not limited to internal progress. The launch of Elevate Business Solutions, LCC was supported by Park City Credit Union. This Credit Union Service Organization (CUSO) helps to contribute to the growth of small businesses and other credit unions with HR assistance and more. In September of 2025, Park City Credit Union also announced that the Merrill headquarters will be home to a brand-new Dunkin' and Baskin Robins location.

Park City Credit Union's growth in 2025 remained rooted in service to its communities. Throughout the year, the organization supported more than 75 local organizations and causes, while employees contributed over 1,000 volunteer hours and completed nearly 50 random acts of kindness.
